Agfa announces that the Wrightington, Wigan and Leigh NHS Foundation Trust, in North West England, UK, has implemented Agfa's DR Retrofit direct radiography (DR) solutions at three of its sites. About 80% of the computed radiography (CR) equipment has been replaced as part of a realignment and modernization project for the radiology department.

Supporting safe, high-quality care

The Wrightington, Wigan and Leigh NHS Foundation Trust is a major acute trust serving the people of Wigan and Leigh, UK (population 350,000). The Trust aims to continuously provide safe, high-quality care to all patients.

The Trust has three hospital sites: Royal Albert Edward Infirmary, Leigh Infirmary and Wrightington Hospital. Facilities also include the state-of-the-art Thomas Linacre Centre outpatient center and a dedicated ophthalmology center.



As part of its program to realign and modernize the radiology services, the Trust decided to upgrade from CR to DR. It chose Agfa as its "Imaging Partner". The contract for the DR Retrofits was signed in September 2017, and implementation was completed in January 2018.
